Established in 1971, Prospectors Earth Sciences is a specialised outdoor equipment import, distribution and supply business. Its 15,000 strong customer base is spread across Australia and overseas and includes mineral exploration companies, surveying companies, foresters, Government departments, emergency services groups and educational bodies.
